1. Tracey & Mike, new to town and living on Blood Road, introduced themselves. They're not sure if they were mis-informed or didn't know the upper part of Woodard Road was still being used. They are officially asking the Select Board to discontinue that part of the Road or add it officially so it takes the liability off them. They claim that the State has no record of it being a Town Road. Jim Barlow said it could have been laid out as a Road and could be added to the State's records. Doug and Marlene said they've been using that road for recreational purposes for years. There was a lot of discussion and looking at maps. Discussed a few options as a group. The Select Board will have to decide how they will pursue this, knowing there will be costs to research this.
2. Amy Williamson was here to discuss the condition of Coddington Hollow Road, Beals Hill Road and Clark Road. There are big pot holes at the Bridge and on the roads and the grading isn't working. Hunter said something needs to be done to the entrances to Bridge. The Board said that more gravel will be added to some of the roads this year, but trying hard to stay within our budget for the taxpayers is important. They will look at the Coddington Hollow Bridge and figure out what to do.
3. Looked at Road bids.
4. Discussed the vacant LCPC position. There are a couple of people interested in representing Waterville on the LCPC Board.
5. Approved bills to be paid.
