- Angela has almost finalized the 2027 Waterville Calendar design, just waiting on a final set of edits / approval from the committee; the Board approved its printing, once finalized
- Annie shared that we'll supply a few photos for Hyde Park's county-wide display; Kristin will purchase frames for the photos, and WHS will reimburse
- Bub asked about raffle tickets cost; general consensus was \$5 per ticket, with a discount when buying \$20 at a time
- Old Home Day (July 11th) planning
 - Annie put together a draft schedule of activities; we'll refine it over the next couple weeks
 - Lucille shared expertise about soliciting business donations for food and such, and volunteered to handle french fries logistics before/on the big day (thank you!); we'll reach out to Library/Church folks about somebody to cook hot dogs
 - Warren/Kimberly are working on parade logistics; got approval from the Sheriff's office, hoping to hear back from the State
 - We agreed on a route for the parade: Start at the Library, head south on Vt 109 to Plot Road, (most) turn around and head back up to the Library, with some stopping at the Town Green for display
 - Maylo will ask around for volunteers to participate, including grand marshals (Amos Tilton and Alice Whiting were suggested); we need to get the word out!
 - Jeff Tilton has kindly volunteered (was voluntold) to organize a baked beans competition; Amanda will help find 3 people to judge
 - Angela will hopefully be able to sell calendars; needs a table set up in Town Hall
 - Acquiring supplies for activities: Annie will find someone to lend a bounce house or two, Laurie will buy and then lend us a cornhole set, and Laurie will give us a couple hay bales for throwing
 - Burton plans to photograph the event all day, and make sure pics land on WHS Facebook and the town website
 - Annie to pick up some blue ribbons for competition winners
 - We'll need a handful of flexible "runner" volunteers to go where/when needed: Burton, Amanda, Bill signed up, for starters
 - Maylo will reach out to contacts about a farm animal petting zoo (e.g. goats)

- Burton and Annie will collate info and organize volunteers leading up to the event; we'll use Burton's email as the contact point – if anyone wants to volunteer or participate in Old Home Day, let Burton know!
